

# HYGIENE RULES FOR BASEBALL

## Sanitary Manager

1. Before a player is allowed on the field, the following questions MUST BE ASKED and ANSWERED:
  - i) Do you have a cough or a fever
  - ii) Have you been outside the region of Montreal
  - iii) Have you been tested for COVID-19
  - iv) Do you live with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19
2. Make sure the player sanitizes their hands before entering field (**bottle provided**)
3. Verify that players:
  - i) Have their own baseball bat and helmet. If not, provide a bat and/or helmet the player will use for the game/ practice (no sharing of equipment).
  - ii) Do not have sunflower seeds or gum in their bag.
  - iii) Have their own water bottle.
4. Take attendance of all those who have arrived at the field (players and adults)

## Players

1. **MASK MUST BE WORN**
2. Washing or disinfecting hands before practice
3. Location of players and equipment (6ft apart).
